We, at LUMUN, believe healthy debate can only take place when perspectives from individuals with diverse experiences are shared. Therefore, keeping in mind the success of this committee last year, the Social Responsibility Department set up a committee for deaf people again in 2023 to provide them with a platform to showcase their skills as debaters as well as communicate their concerns and views. The conversations held in this committee have been enlightening for us, and we hope the delegates shared a similar experience.



Committees in Session

At the heart of LUMUN lie its committees, which are each unique with their own potential for diplomacy and resourcefulness. As the debate gets heated here at Publications, we've got you covered with all the important updates!

Sparks flew in the Security Council yesterday as the three major blocs clashed over solutions to the ongoing crisis. Bloc 1 was spearheaded by the USA and Israel, Bloc 2 was led by Brazil and Bloc 3 was under the leadership of Russia and China. Beyond the ideological tug-of-war, a particularly heated exchange erupted when Russia accused the USA of hypocrisy, highlighting perceived inconsistencies between its actions and its demands for international law to be upheld. Meanwhile, the plight of hostages held by the insurgents remained a pressing concern.

The frigid winds of controversy swept through SPECPOL as delegates tackled the icy issue of resource exploitation in Antarctica. On one side of the iceberg, nations like Zimbabwe stood firm, their voices booming that Antarctica's riches should remain untouched. But Russia, a vocal proponent of development, painted a different picture. Exploitation, they argued, wasn't a wolf at the door, but a key to unlocking scientific advancements that could benefit all mankind. Caught upon the crossfire, Seychelles called the Russian Federation a hypocrite in poetic fashion saying," Goldfish, Selfish. Russia is selfish". Amidst the heated debate. Denmark emerged as a voice of reason. Proposing that the formation of new treaties is absurd and revisions to existing ones should be done. And then there was the audacious proposition, whispered like a crackle in the polar air: the establishment of a Government of Antarctica.

Day two of LUMUN marked a notable shift in PNA's atmosphere, with delegates fully embracing the essence of Pakistani politics. Animated discussions unfolded regarding provincialism and federalism in A-7 as the room reverberated with impassioned descriptions of injustices faced by the people. We are certain the ACD concluded the day with a strained voice, a testament to the fervor and chaos in the room. PNA faced high stakes, requiring the formation of four blocs within a limited time period. Despite the intensity, delegates managed to strike poses for MnD's cameras, adding a touch of flair to the proceedings.

Over in the moot court, the delegates in DISEC saw the committee splitting in half over stances on the creation of a new resolution or body to ensure safety for all as the race for space exploration continues. The chairs made it a point to provide explanations of technical terms used within the committee to ensure delegates new to MUNs understood the proceedings. In response to

requests for an entertainment session, the chairs, in a declaration of their passion for the topic, announced that the whole committee was an entertainment session. This was met with enthusiastic response from the participants. Truly, as Fatima Sarfraz put it, "Space and bombs, guys! What's there not to like?"

We're sure we have all probably laughed at reading UNCSTD's name because why not? 
