Panel Talk Explores Gender-Based Violence with Hina Jilani, Khawar Mumtaz, and Muneeb Qadir

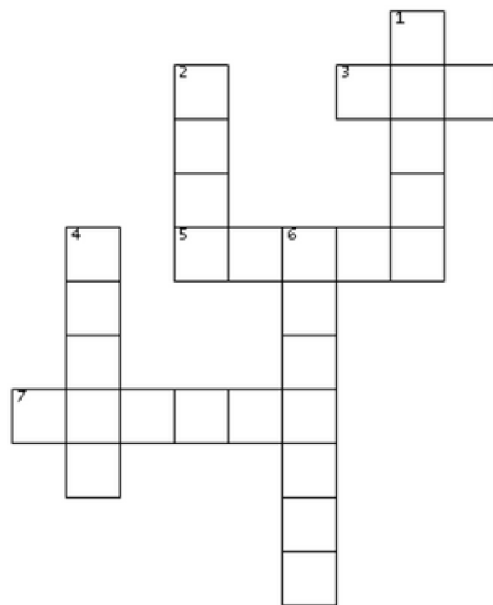
